It is our job to ensure your children feel loved, secure and ready for their next educational step.

Parents – you can help your child by ensuring drop off times are before our Wake and Shake music and movement at 8.30am or before morning snack at 8.45am. Your child will settle better and be ready and eager for all that waits them after morning snack. They will have bonded with friends and feel much more a part of activities. This also makes for a smoother day for all the children in the class and limits disruptions to activities.
